Multi-Solving for Climate Change

A Special Short Course Thursday March 23 - 1:30pm-4:30pm

Multi-solving (v.): Searching for systemic solutions that protect the climate while improving health, equity and well-being. This emerging concept from Climate Interactive (www.climateinteractive.org) gives us a framework for working holistically to address issues while solving for climate change at the same time. You will leave this workshop with a framework for designing projects that multi-solve. We will work in groups to come up with a project that could be a multi-solving example. Or bring a project you are working on and put it to the multi-solving test to see if you are missing some components that would solve more with your time, money and efforts.
